CODE OF CONDUCT

COMMITTEE MEMBER

The way the Committee (*the persons elected at an AGM*) manages the business of Broome Saints Football Club (BSFC), directly affects the Club and the way people see the Club. The Committee Code of Conduct is the foundation for building a strong, united and safe club with a positive future.

This code of conduct defines the expectation and behaviour of the Committee, involved in all activities associated with the Club. This includes any time you are in public wearing clothing that associates you with BSFC or barracking from the sidelines:

- Comply with all policies, procedures and rules of the Club
- Attendance and participation in Committee meetings and the work of the Committee
- Maintain Confidentiality
- Behaving in a manner that does not obstruct the Clubs pursuit and fulfilment of its objectives
- Behaviour that is respectful of diversity, is non-discriminatory and upholds the Clubs values (if defined); and
- Behaviour that does not abuse, physically, sexually or verbally any member of the Club, volunteers, supporters or members of the public

The Committee shall take action against those who have breached the code of conduct, or any incident that brings disrespect to the club and will result in those responsible explaining their action in front of the Committee.

Disciplinary action could take the form of a warning, fine, internal suspension, membership cancelled or suspended, or disqualify that person from the club.

We must put forward a responsible, committed and professional appearance on and off the field. Qualities that BSFC encourages in all members include teamwork, sportsmanship, honesty, commitment, forgiveness, positivity, courage and respect.

It is a condition that when you accept to be a BSFC Committee member, you are expected to follow the Code of Conduct.
